Summary: The first session started with the idea of Library to be a jugular vein of the Academia, mentioning the five laws of library. Access, Utilization and Exploration of E-resources and E-library for research has been shown to be more productive in terms of researching for problems or for publication or for action research. Speaker also mentioned the concept of Dark-Net pertaining to the idea that 95% of internet is not visible to us because of its being the paid domain and that we have been using only 5% in terms of Google Search Engine. The retrieval process is shown to be with the existence of Shape of Science, which is an Information Visualization Project, a conglomerate space for different journals, H-index's etc. E-Library was mentioned to be not an institutional set-up rather a worldwide phenomenon. Digital library set-up require know-how, up-gradation and migration of technology. This set-up is said to include e-books, e-journals, e-database, digital maps, in short E-library do need technological management. Further Speaker mentioned the trend in accessing and using e-library which are static IP, user ID and password method, open access method. The practical demonstration was shown in using DOAB, DOAJ Project Gutenberg, ERIC. He also taught how to do effective information search and search strategies, retrieval techniques by DOI and OPAC method, along with it speaker also mentioned about the information searching tools such as Search Engines, Meta Search Engines, Subject Gateways etc.

Summary: The speaker started his talk with how NEP 2020 since 2015 was on the priority agenda for BJP'S manifesto. Its introduction on 29th July 2020 provides it a comprehensive framework for elementary education to higher education as well as vocational training in both rural and urban India. This NEP is said to be India-centric policy so as to provide skilled man power for new industries to make India as a global leader. In terms of online mode it will not only change what student learn but also how they learn. Proposed institutions like NETF will play formative role for new directions and strategies of education and research by making new software's of learning available in major languages. Teaching and learning will be done in most of the regional languages. DIKSHA is one such platform. Onus is put upon teacher as the major instrument for the dissemination of this new mode of learning. Speaker also talked about the challenges to be faced due to pedagogical changes like issue of equity, handling network, power disruption, and availability of resources to the marginal sections of our society. Major proposed initiatives were mentioned in terms of Pilot studies by NETF, CIET, NIOS, Public digital Infrastructure, online teaching platforms and tools such as SWAYAM, DIKSHA. Creation of virtual labs like SWAYAMPURABHA and proposed bodies like National Assessment Centre, PARAKH, School Boards, NTA are some factors in this directions. Though the presenter was also concerned about how the digital divides reflect the real economic divide in our society as has also been accepted and acknowledged in NEP2020.

Topic: Copyright and Plagiarism

Resource Person: Prof. Suresh Kumar, Department of African Studies, University of Delhi

Summary: The first session started with an introductory remark by the Resource Person to draw a distinction between Copyright infringement and Plagiarism in academic works. The ethical aspect of copyright and plagiarism is also discussed. By elaborating different forms of plagiarism, he also spelled out various aspects of stringent legal provisions and procedural laws regarding Plagiarism and copyright. Citing different judicial decisions pronounced by the High Courts and Supreme Court of India in cases related to plagiarism and copyright violations, he cautioned the participants about how copyright violation and plagiarism can be offensive and can also lead to criminal proceedings. Again, he emphasised on the different aspects of policies and guidelines related to copyright and plagiarism formulated by the UGC and MHRD from time to time. The presentation ended with a Question/ Answer session.

Summary: This session started with an elaborative talk by the resource person about the difference between methodology and methods in the context of research methodology in the field of social sciences. Narrating about the paradigm shift from classroom teaching to virtual teaching, she expressed the need for educators to reskill themselves by enhancing their vocabulary, pronunciation, and voice modulation for effective communication. She also emphasized about the institutional availability of resources and vouched for the adoption of a Blending Learning Management System to practice innovative teaching- learning, and to keep the learner/students engaged during online teaching. She also enlightened the participants to develop efficiency and employability of the educators with readymade professional solutions like MePro solutions and MyLab Programming. She extensively advocated for the need to impart training to teachers and educators to build their capacity of conceptualisation, design and how to conduct qualitative method based research. Mapping out the differences between online and offline research, she stressed for epistemological and ontological construction in social sciences.
